Story Behind Holi








King of death, Hiranyakashipu

4.Holi is celebrated in different country all around the world. This symbolize that Hinduism is exploring day by day.




Negative aspects of Holi

- Nowadays, we eat traditional dishes like Chirashi Sushi and clam soup for the Doll Festival.


Positive Aspects of Hinamasturi Festival

- Very expensive prices over \$10,000-\$20,000
- It takes time to decorate dolls and tools







- Dolls wear traditional Japanese costumes in Hinamatsuri which is the good way to preserve ancient cultural costumes.
- It is celebrated for the good health of all the girls in the family. It symbolizes about the importance of girls.
- There is the similar kind of festivals like Hinamatsuri in Newari community of Nepal.
- As the dolls are preserved for a longer period of time i.e. from Grandparents-Grandchild. It show connection from one generation to another.
