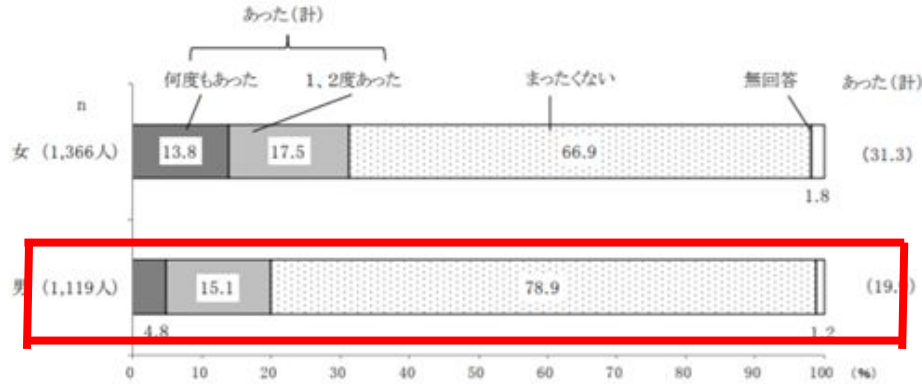

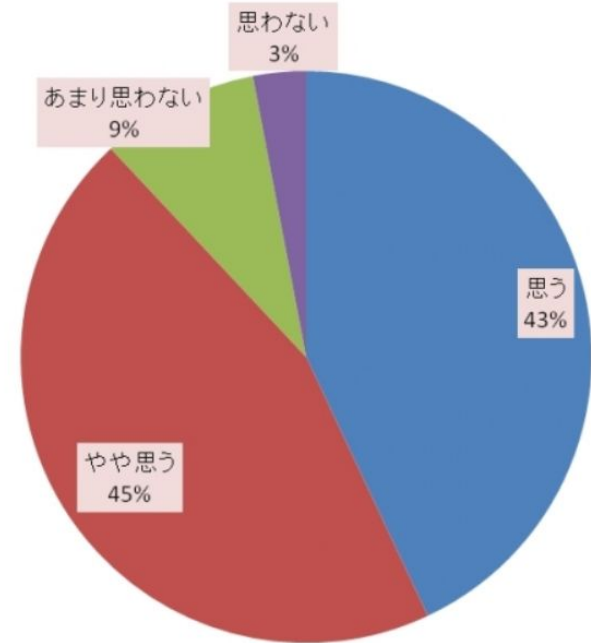

Do you think man domestic violence is not easy to happen?



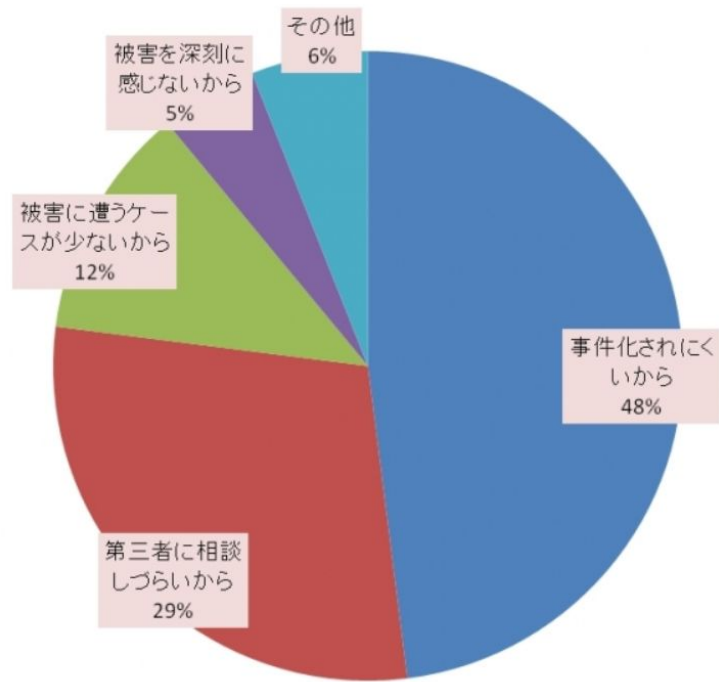

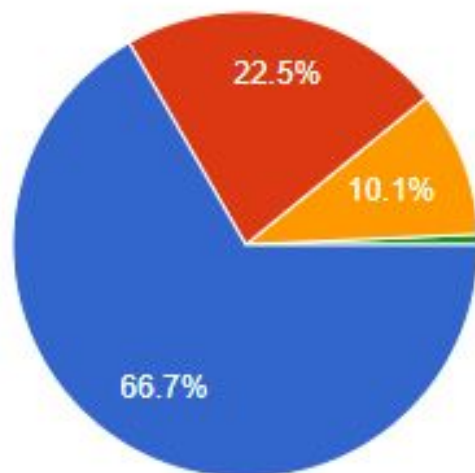

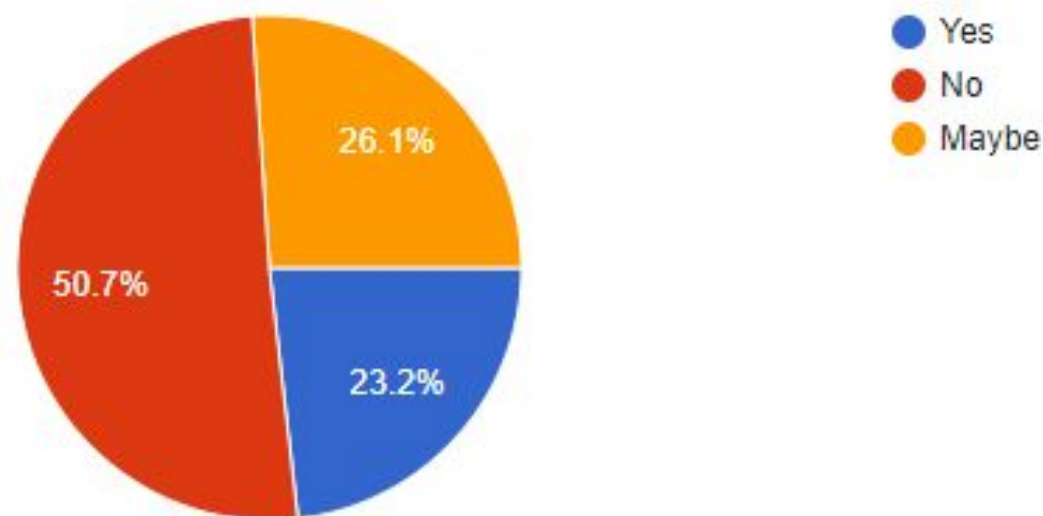

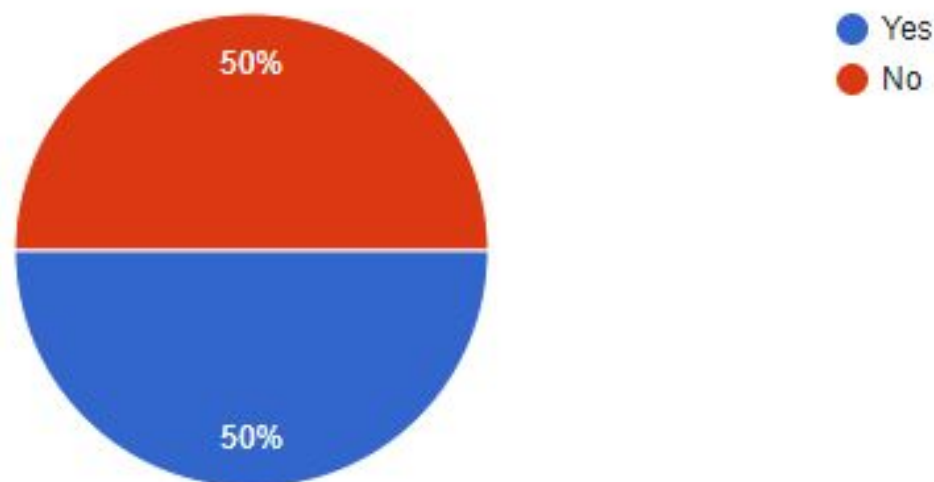

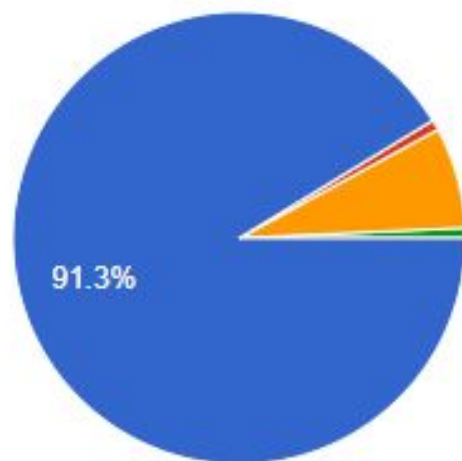
